

Admission as Privately-financed International Student (Undergraduate)
(The classes are offered only in Japanese if you enter through this admission.)

1. Eligibility for Application

Applicant must fulfill both (1) and (2).

- (1) Not be a Japanese citizen or holder of permanent residence status in Japan
- (2) Completion, or expected completion by March 2014, of 12 years of formal education in one's home country or a country other than Japan.

Note) International Baccalaureate degree of Switzerland or France, Abitur of Germany may meet the requirements of (2). For details, please visit this URL:

2. Application Requirements

Applicant must fulfill both (1) and (2).

- (1) Take the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students, Japan Student Services Organization and fulfill both of the below requirements.

Japanese as a Foreign Language: writing, reading comprehension, listening, listening-reading comprehension → a score of not less than 250

Science, Mathematics course 2: a score of not less 265

- (2) Take TOEFL or TOEIC within 2 years before application for Admission as Privately-financed International Student (Undergraduate), and fulfill either of the requirements below.

TOEFL-PBT: a score of not less 430

TOEFL-iBT: a score of not less 39

TOEIC: a score of not less 385
