Changes to Nagoya University's Admission Fee and Tuition Fee Exemption System

Effective from April 2027, we have revised Nagoya University's Admission Fee and Tuition Fee Exemption System in order to actively accept outstanding students from Japan and abroad, and encourage them to pursue their graduate studies by expanding financial support for high-achieving students. However, for Privately-Financed International Students in master's programs who enrolled no later than October 2026, the previous exemption system will be applied as a traditional measure until the end of the standard period of enrollment.

◎Tuition fee exemption for JSPS Research Fellows and for those selected for the THERS Make New Standards Program for the Next Generation Researchers and similar programs will continue even after the new system is implemented.
